Employees will make their open enrollment elections and changes on hy-veePTenroll.com, and any new elections or changes will be effective January 1, 2020.

Open Enrollment is the one time each year when employees can elect new benefits or make changes to existing benefits without having a qualified life event (marriage, birth, divorce, etc.). Most changes can be made without answering health questions. Changes may include: increasing/decreasing coverage, adding/removing dependents, adding a new benefit, or changing beneficiaries, just to name a few examples.
